

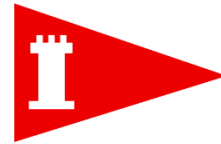

Notice of Race



The Saint Augustine Sailing Sisters (SASS) in conjunction with the SAYC Sailing Center (“Organizing Authority”) are proud to present a Women’s race featuring all female helmspersons and encouraging all female crews.

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*, and any applicable one-design class rules.
- 1.2 A female must be at the helm at all times while racing

2 Eligibly and Entry

- 2.1 Entry may be done online at www.staugustinesailingsisters.com/bikiniRace or www.saycsc.org/event-5333433.

3 Fees

- 3.1 Entry Fee will be \$50.00 for the regatta
- 3.2 SAYCSC Club 420 Charter:
 - a. charter fee is \$50.00 for the regatta
 - b. first come first serve - register early – 12 boats available
 - c. must prove competency of prior racing in Club 420s or equivalent.
 1. Please have a US Sailing Certified Instructor, with knowledge of your abilities contact SAYCSC Sailing Director to discuss.
 2. or; schedule a SAYCSC Club 420 check out with SAYCSC Sailing Director to be completed no later than July 23, 2023.
 - d. charterer is responsible for all damage and must sign SAYCSC waiver of liability.
- 3.3 All payments must be received prior to racing.

5 Sailing Instructions & Classes

- 5.1 Club 420s
- 5.2 Sunfish
- 5.3 OA Reserves the right to cancel and refund any class that fails to have 3 or more entries by July 30, 2023.
- 5.3 Additional classes may be added, please contact SAYCSC if you know of additional a class that can muster 4 or more boats.

6 Venue & Courses

- 6.1 Salt Run or Tolomoto River, St. Augustine, FL

7 Penalty System

- 7.1 Decisions of the protest committee will be final as provided in RRS 70.5.

8 Scoring

- 8.1 The scoring system is as follows: Low Point Scoring as defined in RRS Appendix A.
- 8.2 One throw-out allowed after the fifth race is completed.

9 Prizes

- 9.1 Prizes will be awarded to all classes at the SASS Bikini Race After Party, starting at 1700 at SAYC.
- 9.2 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing

authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

10 SAYC Associate Membership

- 10.1 A portion of the non-member skipper's registration fee will pay for and grant a SAYC Associate Membership of the skipper for the duration of events hosted at the SAYC, that are directly related to this race, regatta or series. By registering for this event and attending any related event hosted at the SAYC clubhouse, skippers (non-member or otherwise) acknowledge that they are responsible for the conduct of their guests (the SAYC Code of Conduct may be found on the notice board inside the clubhouse) and any debt that their guests may incur.
